Your health insurance coverage is coming up for renewal. Your current plan, <<2018 PLAN NAME<sup>6</sup>>>, will continue to be offered in the upcoming 2019 plan year, **with changes**. Our records indicate that you are or will be 30 years old or older as of December 31, 2018. As a result, your eligibility to renew this plan will depend upon your ability to obtain an Exemption Certificate Number (“ECN”) from the federal government. If you want to keep your plan, you must provide your ECN prior to re-enrollment. Your plan will then be renewed on January 1<sup>st</sup> and you just have to pay the new monthly premium.

If you continue to be eligible for this plan, you should review the changes to your benefits, confirm that your health care providers are still in the plan’s network, and confirm any prescriptions you take are still covered.

**What if I want to change plans?**

The 2019 Open Enrollment period is from November 1, 2018 to January 15, 2019. If you would like to switch to a different plan with coverage that starts on January 1, 2019, the deadline to enroll is December 15, 2018.

You can choose a new plan from us, another insurance carrier, or through Connect for Health Colorado. You or your family may also qualify for Health First Colorado (Colorado’s Medicaid Program) or the Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHP+), both of which are public programs that offer low cost health coverage.
